







Do we forgive? What's going on in our lives?

- Forgiveness like air in our lungs, there is only room for us to inhale the next lungful when we've breathed out the forgiveness we've already taken in
- If we refuse to forgive, we won't be able to breathe in any more forgiveness for ourselves, we'll turn blue, suffocate



...not the same as reconciliation


- It takes one person to forgive; it takes two to be reconciled
- Forgiving happens inside the wounded person; reconciliation happens in a relationship between people
- We can forgive a person who never says they are sorry; we cannot be truly reconciled unless they are honestly sorry
- We can forgive even if we do not trust the person who wronged us not to wrong us again; reconciliation can happen only if we can trust the person who wronged us not to wrong us again
- Forgiving has no strings attached; reconciliation has several strings attached





15"If your brother or sister sins, go and point out their fault, just between the two of you. If they listen to you, you have won them over. ¹⁶But if they will not listen, take one or two others along, so that 'every matter may be established by the testimony of two or three witnesses.' ¹⁷If they still refuse to listen, tell it to the church; and if they refuse to listen even to the church, treat them as you would a pagan or a tax collector.










Forgiveness flounders because I exclude the enemy from the community of humans even as I exclude myself from the community of sinners.

When he came up to me as the church was emptying, he said, "How grateful I am for your message, Fraulein. To think that, as you say, he has washed away my sins!" His hand was thrust out to shake mine, but my hand stayed at my side. Angry, vengeful thoughts boiled through me. I tried to smile. I struggled to raise my hand. I could not, and I silently prayed, "Jesus, I cannot forgive him. Give me your forgiveness." As I took his hand, the most incredible thing happened.
