PARTNERING WITH GOD TO BRING HEALING TO OUR WORLD

COMPASSION MONTH - Did you know March is compassion month here at the Vineyard? Now is a great time to get involved! One of the biggest way we are able to reach out to the community and meet the practical needs of the people around us is through our Fruit of the Vine food shelf. In 2022, we averaged 1,153 individuals served and 32,497 pounds of food given away each month by the Fruit of the Vine. Beyond meeting people's practical need for food and clothing, it's also our goal to love every single person that comes through the doors. There are lots of ways to serve: Volunteer at one of our food distributions on Tuesday evenings or Saturday mornings or another time, donate food or clothing to our food shelf during office hours or our weekend services, or put a few dollars in the poor box! COMMUNION TEAM - Are you looking for a next step to become more involved in our community? Becoming a part of the communion team is a great way to partner with what God is doing in our church. PENTECOST 2023

“Be filled with the Spirit.”

– Ephesians 5:18

Our lives can be full of so many things: commitments to stay on top of, relationships to invest in, and responsibilities to manage. We can be full of stress and anxiety. And in our darker moments, we can be filled with pride, greed, lust or anger.

But, as Christians, it is our hope to be full of the Holy Spirit above anything else. The Apostle Paul wasn't talking about receiving a one time “fill-up” of the Spirit.

Ephesians 5:18 could be more literally translated, “be filled and continue to be filled with the Spirit in an on-going and never ending manner.” The truth is that we are in constant need of the Holy Spirit's power. The good news is that his filling is continually available to us.

Here is how author Simon Ponsonby describes being filled with the Holy Spirit: “It is a constantly repeatable, deepening experience of God's Spirit, who brings a greater revelation of the person and work of Christ, a blazing love for Christ, a greater and more effective empowering witness to Christ and a transforming conformity to the character of Christ.”

As Jesus prepared to leave this earth, he promised to send the Holy Spirit. He said the Spirit would be a helper, a counselor and an advocate as God's personal presence in

each of us. The work of the Holy Spirit is so encompassing in our lives! We're excited about some tangible opportunities to experience more of the Holy Spirit in the coming weeks. This spring, as we lean into this focus as a church, we believe that God will meet us in powerful ways.

This day is not only for those of you already in an Alpha small group, but we're opening this up to the whole church. Here is how one recent attendee described coming to the Holy Spirit Day.

“I knew that the Alpha Holy Spirit Day was going to open some new doors for me, but I also had apprehensions. Praying was something that previously made me nervous, especially hands on prayer. But, when the time came to receive prayer that day, I decided to go for it. In one sense, as one of the leaders prayed for me, nothing extraordinary happened. But, on the other hand, something wonderful happened. It felt good, it felt happy, and it felt right. And it did open up a deeper relationship with God for me. Since that time, I have been growing in my experience of prayer and have even taken a few risks in offering to pray for others. It has been such a rewarding journey. My

encouragement to new people is this: The Holy Spirit is always there. You just have to let him in more and more.”

Whether experiencing the Holy Spirit is brand new for you, or you've had a long history with the Holy Spirit, we believe God has something in store for you at this event. We would love to have you join us for the Alpha Holy Spirit Day.

April 23 - May 28


